From Our Pastor:

Archbishop Bernardin now has an illegitimate and invalid vote for communion in the hand, but he needs some kind of permission from the Vatican or there will be even more confusion and chaos in the Church. (Many of us remember the 1970s, Catholic Schools, Universities, Seminaries, Orphanages, and Nursing homes closing by the dozens, religious sisters and priests abandoning their vocations by the thousands etc.) Archbishop Bernardin now approaches the Vatican with his falsified vote tally and indirectly threatens an open schism with Rome if no lead way is given.
