IMPORTANT DATA TO FOLLOW

- Please be at church **about 15 minutes** before Mass begins.
- Report to your captain.
- Greet people as they arrive.
- Keep inside wooden doors closed. It keeps out noise, not to mention heat and cold.
- Once Mass begins, please go inside the church and participate in the Mass.
- At Offertory, take up the collection. If there are no Gift Bearers, please bring up to the altar the bread, wine, rose and the collection. Put the collection in front of the altar.
- After Mass, put the collection in the safe in the sacristy.
- Also, pick up hymnals, put up kneelers and turn out lights.
- Dress Attire: Please dress appropriately for the ministry you are doing.
- When a weekend splits between two different months, ie. June 30th is on a Saturday and July 1st is Sunday, the June usher team should do the Saturday Mass and the July teams the Sunday Masses. So basically, just follow the monthly calendar.
